

The Onalaska Show Choir Classic is on Friday night January 15 at Onalaska High School.

- **Students need to be there by 4:30 pm and be picked up between 7 and 8pm. The school is not providing transportation to this event.**
- **Please BRING ALL costume parts to Onalaska high school and change there. Remember your shoes, all of your costumes parts in your garment bag, and deodorant. Wear your Show Choir Tshirt there so we all match when we go back in to listen to groups.**
- At 4:30 pm students need to **report to the Wilson street entrance** at Onalaska High School to get their performers stamp and be escorted to our homeroom. I will be waiting for you there. If you are late, you still need to go to that entrance to get your performers stamp. That hand stamp will get you in free to all the events of the weekend, including Saturday if you want to come back. The homeroom is the place where students will keep their things while they are performing. Once in the homeroom, students can go change into their costume and put the finishing touches on their look.
- At 5:30 our hosts will take us to the warmup area where we can run through our show.
- At 6:00 we will perform in the gym for the audience. Immediately following our performance we will go to hear a judges critique to help us improve our performance in the future. After the critique students can change back into their clothes and go in again to listen to other Middle School Show Choirs. Lincoln performs at 6:40, Logan Middle at 7:00, and two other great groups from Jefferson ILL at 7:20 and Sauk Prairie WI at 7:40.
